STANDING COMMITTEES

BUILDING & GROUNDS

The Building & Grounds committee is a resource by providing input and counsel to the staff regarding facility improvements, maintenance, long term planning and property development. The Building & Grounds committee meets a minimum of four times a year with meetings added as needed to perform its assigned tasks.

FINANCE

The Finance Committee is responsible for assisting the board in ensuring the organization maintains good fiscal health. The Finance Committee meets on a monthly basis typically on the 4th Monday.

GOVERNANCE

The Governance Committee strengthens the Board by evaluating the existing board and establishing guidelines for Board Development. It mounts a year-round effort to enlist new Board and committee members in order to ensure that a full complement of seats is filled under the Association by-laws. The committee monitors Board participation and takes necessary steps, including separating inactive and/or ineffective members, to maintain high levels of Board involvement. It also evaluates the quality of the experience of serving on the Board and acts to make improvements.

HEALTHY LIVING

The Healthy Living Advisory Committee is a resource by providing input and counsel to the staff regarding existing and new programs of the YMCA in the areas of Membership, Wellness and Aquatics. The HLC will generally meet a minimum of four times a year with meetings added as needed to perform its assigned tasks.

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

The Youth Development Advisory Committee is a resource by providing input and counsel to the staff regarding existing and new programs of the YMCA in the areas of Child Care, Youth Sports, Youth and Family and Gymnastics. The YDC will generally meet a minimum of four times a year with meetings added as needed to perform its assigned tasks.

HUMAN RESOURCE

The Human Resources Advisory Committee is a resource by providing input and counsel to the staff regarding human resources strategies and policies of the YMCA. The HRC meets as needed to perform its assigned tasks.

MARKETING

The Marketing Advisory Committee will focus on internal and external marketing strategies and opportunities. The MAC meets as needed to perform its assigned tasks.

The Risk Management Advisory Committee focuses on internal and external risk management, safety for both internal and external areas. The RMAC meets as needed to perform its assigned tasks.

COMMITTEE AUTHORITY

All committees receive their authority from the board and its actions are subject to review and approval by the board. Each committee has an approved board commission and a annual chart of work. The committees have the authority to establish ad hoc groups from time to time as may be necessary to carry out its work.

COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

Committees are comprised of individuals with a wide range of skills, interests and experiences. Size of committees varies depending on type of committee and to encourage engagement by all.

COMMITTEE TERMS

Committee members are scheduled for one term of no more than three (3) years, which may be renewed for an additional term of up to three years. After that point, committee members are encouraged to stay engaged on another committee.
