## COMPANY ELIGIBILITY

1. Every participant in the Corporate Cup Challenge must be employed by the registered company. Employment is defined as part-time or full-time.
2. Participants must be 18 years of age or older.
3. Companies of all sizes are eligible.
4. Small and Mini companies (50 or less employees) can combine to form a team.
5. Only companies with 50 or less employees can merge with another company.
6. Participants must fill out the eligibility form via link. Failure to complete the form will lead to automatic disqualification for that team.
7. Participants cannot compete for multiple companies.
8. Participants can play in every event.
9. The company coordinator must fill out the rosters and return them to the YMCA by the April 30th registration deadline.



## OLYMPIC STYLE SCORING

All events will have a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finisher. First place scores 5 points, second place scores 3 points, and third place scores 1 point. At the Closing Ceremony, first place finishers will receive a gold medal, second place finishers will receive a silver medal, and third place finishers will receive a bronze medal. This applies to every event. Additional Awards on pg. 5.

## EVENT COST

Your company can pick and choose which events it wishes to compete in. You can buy an unlimited number of teams per event. Every roster spot is worth \$20. As roster sizes vary by event, prices will vary.

### Tip:

Buy and form your package around what your employees want to do. If you have 9 basketball players, buy 3 basketball teams, if you have 1 chess player, buy one chess team.

## EVENT DESCRIPTIONS

The event descriptions provide the number of players permissible, gender make-up, and minimum number of teams. If the minimum number of teams is not met, team members will be notified that the event is cancelled. Specific in-game rules for each event can be found in the YMCA Corporate Cup Challenge Rulebook.

### 5K RUN-1 MILE WALK

**Date:** Saturday, May 30

**Location:** YMCA

**Time:** 8:00am

**General Info/Game Rules:**

- This is an unlimited roster event.
- Participants will be given a bib with a tracker attached.
- Only the top three male and female finishers will receive placement points.
- Times will be recorded.
- The mile walk is for participants to represent their companies; no points are awarded for participation.

### VOLLEYBALL (COED)

**Date:** Saturday, June 6

**Location:** YMCA

**Time:** 6:00pm and 9:00am

**General Info/Game Rules:**

- This is a Coed event
- There are a total of 8 roster spots available.
- The team must consist of 6 participants in order to compete. There must be a minimum of two women on the roster. A team not meeting the qualifications will forfeit. (6 to play).
- A match will consist of the best two out of three sets. Each set will be played to 15, win by 2.
- If there are less than 4 teams, the event will be canceled.

### TRIVIA

**General Info/Game Rules:**

- 5 roster spots available
- Teams can be fully male, fully female or coed.
- If there are less than 3 teams, the event will be canceled.





## PICKLEBALL (MEN'S, WOMEN'S, COED)

**Time:** 8:00am

### General Info/Game Rules:

- Two roster spots are available.
- There is a men's division, women's division, and coed
- If there are less than 4 teams in any division, that tournament will be canceled.
- A match will consist of the best two out of three sets. Each set will be played to 11, win by 2.

## 3V3 BASKETBALL (MEN'S AND WOMEN'S)

**Date:** Saturday, June 27

**Location:** YMCA

**Time:** 9:00am

### General Info/Game Rules:

- 4 roster spots are available. 3 to play.
- There is a men's division and women's division.
- If there are less than 3 teams in either division, that tournament will be canceled.
- Games will be two 5-minute halves.
- Each team is allowed one timeout per half. Timeouts are 60 seconds.

## CORNHOLE

**Date:** Saturday, July 11

**Location:** YMCA

**Time:** 9:00am

### General Info/Game Rules:

- 2 roster spots are available.
- Teams can be any combination of male and female players.
- If there are less than 4 teams in the tournament, the tournament will be canceled.

## KICKBALL (COED)

**Time:** 9:00am

### General Info/Game Rules:

- This is a Coed event.
- There are 11 roster spots available. There needs to be a minimum of 4 women on the roster in order to compete.
- There are 5 innings in each game.
- 9 will play the field but all 11 will hit in the lineup as Extra Kickers.
- Line-up cards are required. Numbers will be handed out on match day.
- Home and Away teams will be decided by a coin flip.
- In the event of a tie at the end of 5 innings, the following innings will be played with a runner on 2nd, no outs. This will continue until a winner is decided.

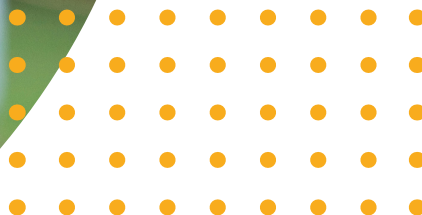
